MEMBERSHIP PROPOSAL FEEDBACK

Thank you to all the members who commented and made suggestions on the membership proposal. There were many overlapping responses. These topics are addressed below. Your membership team Olga Hendrickson, Tracey Erway, Kristine Strasburger, Eleanor Thomas and Chris Stanko

- 1. MEMBERSHIP FEES: 2021 being the 1st year of the new merged organization and being our COVID recovery year we believe a low membership fee will help our members through this trying time. We do understand that WE United members are paying a little bit more than they have previously. Our membership price will go up in 2022 but not much. We will try to keep the membership fees low. Fees will increase if there is a need for additional income for the organization. Our membership fee is low enough to encourage members who do not want to compete to be part of the organization as well as our competing members.
- 2. YOUTH MEMBERSHIP: We are wanting to encourage youth to get involved in WE. Therefore, keeping the fee "FREE" for now seems more inviting. Membership applications will need to be filled out for youth, just like everyone else. Horses will also need to be recorded. In the future if indicators show us there is a need for additional income, there could be a nominal fee for youth.
- 3. HORSE RECORDING: All current WE United and Confederation horse recordings will be grandfathered into the merged organization. For our Charter year (COVID recovery year), we would like to offer horse recordings free to any new horses until December 31, 2020. As of January 1, 2021 there will be a \$20 Lifetime horse recording fee. This gives our members with new horses a chance to get them recorded for Free. It also gives new members a chance to get their horses recorded for Free. With the \$20 fee, we can use the monies for Education, scholarships, AO help, awards...possibilities are endless. We would like to suggest having all recorded horses transferable if sold. The recording number goes with the horse. It will take just a small amount of paperwork. In the future if indicators show us there needs to be a change, we can visit that.
- 4. ONE TIME SHOW VOUCHER: We will try this for our Charter year and revisit it at the end of 2021
- 5. MEMBERSHIP/AO \$5: We will try this for our Charter year with the goal of supporting local groups (Affiliate Organizations) in their efforts to help grow the sport and will reevaluate at the end of 2021.
